The Serge Weinberg Awards Ceremony

Paris, June 27, 2024 - Foundation S - The Sanofi Collective, the philanthropic organization supported by Sanofi, along with Future4care, a European ecosystem dedicated to digital health, and CentraleSupélec 21st, today awarded the first Serge Weinberg Trophies at the One Health4All event held at Future4care. Named in honor of Foundation S's honorary president, well-known for his long-standing commitment to younger generations, these trophies aim to annually reward the most innovative and impactful digital solutions that contribute to the integrated "One Health" approach to health. The jury for this inaugural edition was chaired by Chrysoula Zacharopoulou, Secretary of State for Development and International Partnerships.

« One Health » - An Integrated Approach to Health

In the context of demographic transitions and climate change, marked by multiple health and environmental crises, it is crucial to adopt a holistic vision of health. Public health, traditionally focused on human health, must now include the impact on the environment and ecosystems. This is the goal of the "One Health" concept, which, through its integrated approach, addresses health in its entirety: human, environmental, and animal health.

A Time for Collective Reflection

The morning began with a speech by Frédéric Oudéa, President of Sanofi and Foundation S - The Sanofi Collective, followed by three panel discussions focusing on some of the most critical issues related to the "One Health" concept, such as the evolution of public health policies, the role and use of digital technology, and the perspective of future generations. The 2024 Winners

The Gold Trophy, worth €30,000, was awarded to Arshia Gratiot, founder of Eupnoos, an application that uses your smartphone's microphone and advanced algorithms to analyze your breathing and monitor your lung function over time. This non-invasive approach enables early detection and informed decision-making, particularly for people with respiratory issues, mainly residing in the Global South.

The Silver Trophy, worth €20,000, was given to Guillaume Soto-Mayor, founder of Egregor. This collective fights against environmental and health degradation, promoting a "One Health" approach.

Lastly, the Jury Prize, offering one year of support from Future4care, was awarded to Sébastien Rodillon, founder of AppHop, a project combating medication waste through an intelligent AI model.
